(1) Scholarship for International Students

1) Scholarship for International Students

For the first semester, a partial tuition waiver is possible based on the applicant's level of TOPIK.

- ① Students with TOPIK Level 5 or higher : 100% Total tuition (Instruction Fee + admission fee) waived
- ② Students with TOPIK Level 4 : 60% of Instruction Fee waived
- ③ Students with TOPIK Level 3 : 50% of Instruction Fee waived
- ④ Students who have completed the Korean Language Course (Grade 4 or higher) at WU : 50% of Instruction Fee waived
- ⑤ Students in arts or sports majors : 50% of Instruction Fee waived
- ⑥ Students who have completed the Korean Language Course at WU : Admission fee waived

From the second semester, a merit scholarship is applied depending upon a student's grade point average, from 30% to 60%, based on the Wonkwang University International Student Scholarship Regulations.

From the second semester

2) TOPIK Scholarship

Students who obtain a TOPIK certification or raise a TOPIK level after being admitted are eligible for financial aid.

| Section | Scholarship | Remark |
|-----------------------------|-------------|--|
| Students with TOPIK Level 6 | ₩400,000 | - when Level 3 students obtain a Level 6 certification without completing the Level 4 or 5 test - eligible receive only once |
| Students with TOPIK Level 5 | ₩300,000 | - when Level 3 students obtain a Level 5 certification without completing the Level 4 test - after which they obtain a Level 6 certification, they can receive a Level-Up Scholarship |
| Students with TOPIK Level 4 | ₩200,000 | - when students with no TOPIK certification obtain a Level 4 certification - after which they have successfully completed their TOPIK level, they can receive a Level-Up Scholarship |
| Level-Up Scholarship | ₩100,000 | From TOPIK Level 3, when a student raises one level up, ₩100,000 will be granted. (Level 3 -> Level 4, Level 4 -> Level 5, Level 5 -> Level 6) |

- When admitted, a student with a TOPIK level of 6 cannot receive both a TOPIK Scholarship and tuition waiver. A student with a TOPIK level lower than 6 can receive a TOPIK Scholarship when he or she raises a TOPIK level.

3) Language Excellence Scholarship

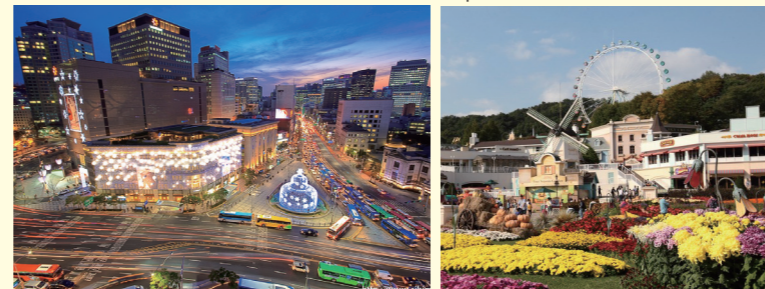

Students with a previous semester's grade point average of 3.0 or higher, and one of the following certifications satisfied, will receive 25% of tuition, with a recommendation from a dean.
